

There are 2 other versions of the book with similar name, all contains artwork by Dennis Jones. One version has the same art style as this one minus the dialog and that's for pre-reader (for babies to gaze at) The other one is tailored toward a more older reader (2nd-5th graders?) This one is just perfect for toddlers as the title of the book implies. The art is very good, typical of Dennis Jones. If you compare this with the Read with Me Bible for the older reader you would notice that in this book Dennis' art is much more developed. I have the 3 versions by Dennis Jones and it's just amazing to see how his style develops. The bible stories contained in this book are the famous stories you've

probably heard a thousand times. Genesis, Noah, Moses, David vs Goliath, Daniel and the lions, Jonah and the big fish, etc. They are stories picked from old and new testamentIt's a good introductory book for the little ones and I think Dennis Jones has done a superb job with the art!

Love it! Bought for my two year son and we read this every night for our bedtime stories. It helps him learn The Bible. He can already tell me about creation, Noah, Jesus, and more which helps lay the foundation for understanding The Bible. Pictures are colorful and words are on his level so he can understand. It has a great selection of stories. Very happy.

I teach preschoolers in Sunday School (3-4 years old). They love the pictures and stories in this book. Each story isonly a couple of pages long. Pictures are terrific! The kids like to take the book and "read it" themselves!! Story stays truet to the Bible, but written so they can understand and learn. We have many other kid Bibles, but I almost always turn tothis one to teach with.

I really like the fact that each page has very limited text, because my two-year-old daughter likes to speed through her books, and this gives me time to actually read it before the page gets flipped. The translation is a great parallel to adult texts; I can relate the text to actual scripture verses in my own bible, so I know my daughter is getting an actual translation from God's Word rather than someone's personal summary of the stories. My only complaint is that toddlers can be rough on books, so the paper pages get torn. However, I knew that when I bought it, so I still give 5 stars :).
