

I love this. I try to read it every day and learn new words. It has a lot of good words that people should know and that definitely make you sound smarter. I think enriching your vocabulary is so important. Everyone should own this book! It not only tells what each word means and how it's pronounced but also includes a brief history and example. Brilliant!

I am a zealous (word #100) reader, so I already have a fairly advanced vocabulary and I did not find any new words here to use. But it is always a good thing to refresh one's understanding of those like byzantine, Catch-22, kitsch, and Svengali if for no other reason than to dust off old friends and start using them again. This book, however, does offer more. First, it employs some superb quotes to illustrate the correct meaning of the words in context. Second, in some cases it gives the background of the term you are using (e.g., Machiavellian, quintessential, or white elephant) so that it takes on a richer character, which makes it easier to recall and to apply in more nuanced ways. For the advanced student, I would recommend the "mispronounces" book in this series--after all, you can't sound smart without saying your words correctly and the vocabulary level is more challenging.
