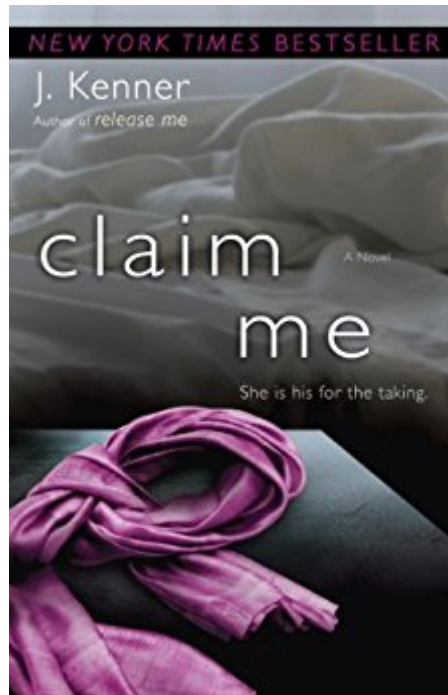


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Claim Me (The Stark Trilogy, Book 2)

I started reading Release Me and before I had read half way through, I had ordered Claim Me. This book continues the roller-coaster that is Damien and Nikki, and with their agreement about the painting coming to a close, and Nikki becoming a million dollars richer, can their relationship continue? Ms. Kenner gives a brief synopsis of book 1 in this book, so it can be read as a standalone novel, but to get the full depth of their relationship, it should be read as part of the trilogy. Because of Nikki's early life as a pageant queen she has had little control over her life as her mother controlled everything, you would expect her to rebel against control from Damien. Although she submits to him as a lover, she discovers her strength in being able to say no to Damien. Can't wait for number 3.

Excellent book! I was immediately pulled back into Nikki and Damien's story. I love them as a couple! I couldn't wait to find out all about Damien's secrets. The author has a great attention to detail so I was captivated. Claim Me is book two in the Stark Trilogy and starts where book one left off. I like that throughout the book details from Release Me (book 1) were brought up as a reminder of what had happened, they were weaved in well. I think Nikki is a strong character but with so much turmoil throughout this story she had a hard time coping but remained strong. I really felt for her but wished she would have been more open with Damien about her feelings. I think Damien was more open in this book but not as forthcoming with the information but he did finally get there. The details of his past do come to light and it was heartbreaking but just as Nikki thought. I like that they seem like a normal couple in an extremely hard situation. Damien is protective but not overly controlling and domineering though he does like to be in control. Nikki isn't internally whiny, I think she has valid concerns. I also loved the fact that she doesn't push and pester Damien to open up to her, she wants him to do it because he wants to. I thought they were more emotional and in tune with one another in this book and I loved that. It was so obvious how much they loved each other and even though there were intense moments, I thought it was all very romantic in a way too. I love them together! This book had a good pace. I never felt it was slow, but steady with an even build. I was slightly anxious throughout wanting my questions from book one to be answered. I liked Damien and Nikki's lighter moments, I thought they were fun and playful. There were LOTS of serious sex scenes... WOW! All my questions from book one were answered and some new ones were introduced as well but I'm sure they'll be covered in book three. And the last chapter? It just about

killed me! I thought it had a great ending and I'm ready for Complete Me (book 3). Overall, I think this is a great, well written story. I love Nikki and Damien and can't get enough!

I first read Release Me a couple months ago and then reread it again this past weekend in preparation of the new release. I am absolutely in love with Nikki and Damien. I kind of felt like it was a cross between the 50 Shades and Crossfire series. Needless to say I have been eagerly awaiting the next addition to this series, Claim Me. Ms Kenner did not disappoint. Claim Me starts off right where Release Me ends. The painting is still being worked on and Nikki and Damien are thoroughly enjoying their time together...and frankly so am I! In Claim Me secrets that Damien has been holding so close to are finally revealed and their love is definitely tested. There are some new challenges and twists to their story including the paparazzi, crazy ex-bosses, Nikki's mom (who rears her ugly head in a roundabout way), Damien's dad, employment, best friends and the biggest secret of all. However, watching them fall in love (not to mention the crazy, hot steamy sex scenes) made this a hard book to put down. The thought of having to wait until the end of July to find out the fate of Nikki and Damien in Complete Me is extremely painful. This hot, erotic love story is not to be missed.

Jump on the roller-coaster of Nikki and Damien's relationship and hang on tight. Julie Kenner continues this fabulous intense relationship the same way it started in Release Me. Nikki gets pushed into a corner to deal with her past and the actions she used to cope. The road isn't easy as both Nikki and Damien have to work toward trusting each other by being open and honest. The intense chemistry remains with inventive sexual encounters. Sit back and enjoy the ride!

Claim Me is the second installment in the Stark Trilogy. We pick up where we left off in Release Me. Nikki wants more from Damien. He knows all of her secrets, but he has not opened up for her, telling her the darkness that haunts him. She has guessed about the abuse that he was subjected to, but he has never confirmed it. The closer that the painting of her gets complete, the more desperate and possessive Damien becomes. He does not want their agreement to end. Nikki tries to assure him that a contract is not what is binding her to him, but Damien has problems trusting people. He is trying, but where Nikki is concerned his primal urges and instincts seem to overwhelm him. Nikki is just as jealous and possessive of Damien, but she does not think she is good enough for him, so instead of being confident in their connection she seeks out pain to ground her. J. Kenner continues the story of two traumatized individuals who find in each other solace, love, and a home.

They keep making the same mistakes over and over, but Nikki wants them to come face to face with their monsters so that they can move on and be together without restraint or secrets. Damien does not know how to handle the intense feelings that he has with Nikki. He wants to claim her, possess her, dominant her, and own her heart and soul. Can Damien come clean with Nikki and tell her about the demons of his past? Can Nikki put herself fully in Damien's control? Claim Me will arouse, seduce,, captivate, dominant, and possess you.
