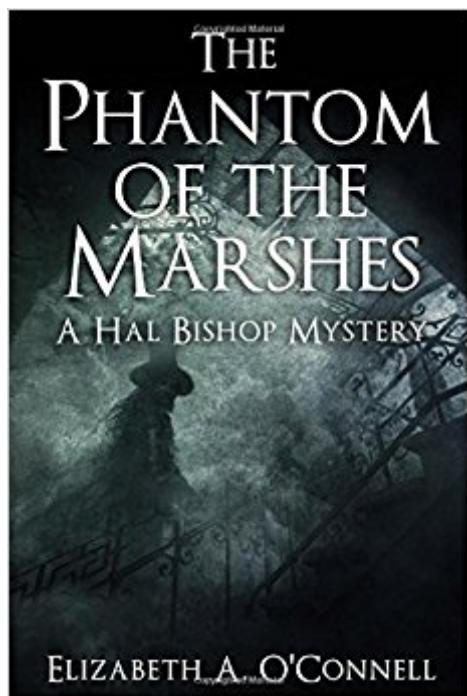

This is the third installment of the increasingly intriguing story of Hal and Jem Bishop. They're cursebreakers in a world much like Victorian London, but with an industrial revolution based on magic, not steam. In this book, Hal and Jem are called out by the son of a colleague of their late father, the architect of the new magic technology. But while trying to discover why the son is being pursued by a death phantom, Hal and Jem discover that something even more disturbing is going on, and it may have to do with the death of their father. This series has wonderful world-building - the grimy feel of the mid-19th century English industrial landscape is mixed with an almost Lovecraftian

unseen world of the supernatural, giving the series a Gothic feeling that sends shivers up your spine. Hal and Jem are great characters, and I hope to read more of them soon
