

I have the giant Hadzic tome of Regional Anesthesia as well as my original Bridenbough. I wanted something to keep on the office shelf that was smaller for use as a quick reference for blocks that I don't do routinely. Since I use the ultrasound daily for blocks, I am accustomed to looking at ultrasound pictures. Dr. Gray has drawn thick white circles around everything so you lose the sense of the overall tone of a typical ultrasound. His pictures are unlike anything you see in daily practice with a well used ultrasound.
