

Nick Slade's father ... is still on the loose ... still making it a priority to kill Bobbie in order to make his son angry enough to kill. Nick still has nightmares about becoming like his father. Over the next few days, parents of the lost children begin to die .. in a horrible, gruesome manner. And no one is talking secrets are buzzing around like flies at a picnic.What happened 32 years ago? Why were these children taken? What connects them to each other? But her grit, her determination and sheer vision for doing what is needed has me on the edge of my seat for every book. Debra Webb has a way...what a fabulous way of creating characters that you can't turn away from. Whether they are heroes or the most vile killers. You want to see what makes them tick. This is the first book I've read by Debra Webb. From looking at her website, I'm definitely late to the party. What I didn't realize when I requested this book is that it is the third in a series. It was very well-written and the intricate plot kept me guessing but it starts IMMEDIATELY after the book before it (like the next day). Webb creates an amazing cast of characters with a tangled mass of intimate connections that made the beginning of the book confusing for me. I'm sure if I had read the first two in the series I would have known exactly who everyone was and been more entertained by the subtle references. It's clear the author is working hard to not overload a new reader and still give enough information but I felt like I'd turned on a TV show in the middle. Remember when they used to snippets of what happened before each scene? "Previous on Miami Vice..." That's what it was like. Yes, I was an 80's kid and I was OBSESSED with Miami Vice, Wise Guy, Crime Story, all those! Once it really gets going, the plot itself is chilling.
