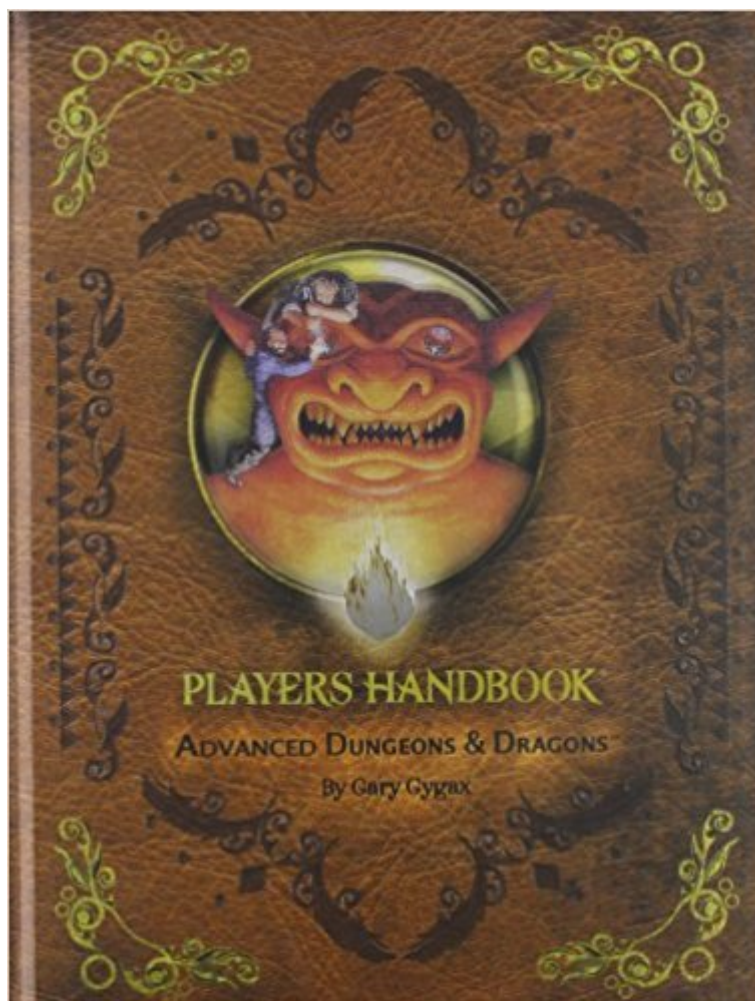

I remember when the Players Handbook (PHB) 1st hit the open market. I was 17...it was a long awaited book. For Wizards of the Coast to bring back the 1st edition core books of Advanced D&D is a great moment. To do this in honor of its creator the late E. Gary Gygax (E.G.G.) is amazing and much appreciated. This edition of the Players Handbook is very high quality. It is well bound and will last far longer than the original publications from the 70's and 80's. The original manuscript is used, including all the mistakes & spelling errors that were included in the original texts. No kidding, they are again presented for your reading enjoyment and frustration. Oh yeah...I remember well working out the logic of what was written, versus what was intended. Over all this is simply a quality product. If you used to play the game...back in the day; thumbing through these pages are going to be a welcome stroll down memory lane. If you've never played 1st edition AD&D, here is where it all began. Either way it will not disappoint.

I'm an old school player and DM who still has a group that plays every other week. We play 1st edition rules only (and have for a very long time). Our old 1st edition manuals are all falling apart and have so many notes, highlights, coffee/soda stains, etc. that they are barely recognizable from the original. Enter this gem of a purchase. Awesome reproduction of the original. The only problem I have with it is that I don't want to bring it to my game nights because I don't want to crease the spine or get Cheetos or Mountain Dew on the pages (while casting magic missile into the darkness). :) Great buy if you're an old school AD&D player. I'm just getting into the OSR movement, and I'm already obsessed with collecting the 1st edition books. These reprints are truly God-sent as it's virtually impossible to find an affordable copy of the original 1e PHB in pristine condition. As for the book I got - The Premium AD&D 1e PHB reprint is fantastic reproduction. Great production values, and you can tell that WOTC really stayed true to their intent of delivering a collector-worthy product. A must-have for every D&D fan.

It's just the best version of the game. This book was written by Gary Gygax, and reads more like a tutorial on gaming than a rulebook. I love that. For anyone wishing they could go back to the time when RPGs were about roleplaying and not about gimmicky video gamey playing, these books are

for you. If you've never tried 1st edition (and yes, I'm speaking to you 3.5 gamers out there) then you HAVE to try first edition. Just be aware you'll have to have more material prepared, as half of your game session will not be spent looking up obscure rules. But there's the brakes! P.S. - Buy it. Don't think. Buy it. Do it. Do it now. Stop looking at the button. Push the button. Add to cart. Check out. Wait two days. PLAY THIS GAME!
