

## Synopsis

The Magic Strings of Frankie Presto by Mitch Albom is a novel about the fictional musician Frankie Presto and his amazing journey through music and life. Frankie's life story is told from the perspective of music, a fictional narrator. This is fitting, given that Frankie was one of the world's greatest guitarists. The story, however, begins at its end: Frankie has died during a music festival. During a performance, his body levitates and then drops to the stage. The novel opens at Frankie's funeral, where music-industry figures - including nonfictional musicians such as Lyle Lovett and Ingrid Michaelson - have gathered to pay their respects and share their thoughts about the deceased guitarist. Music, the narrator, uses the opportunity of the funeral to reflect on Frankie's life. Please Note: This is a summary and analysis of the book and NOT the original book!

Frankie Presto was one of the world's greatest guitarists. Born in Spain during the time of the dictator, Franco, his mother died shortly after he was born, and he was taken by a nun who swore to look after him. The Magic Strings of Frankie Presto by Mitch Albom is the story of Frankie's life, told from the point of view of music—"music is the omniscient narrator" and is a reflection on the forces that shaped his life. The story begins with Frankie's death, opening with his funeral where people he interacted with in life tell how he affected them. While Frankie Presto is a fictional character, actual historical figures also appear in the story, and the musical theme, in particular the seemingly magic strings of Frankie's guitar, appears throughout. While the musical motif adds a lyrical quality to the story, its constant

use lessens the impact to a degree. This is especially true of the phrase "Everyone joins a band in this life." Instaread's Summary & Analysis of *The Magic Strings of Frankie Presto* by Mitch Albom is an outstanding review of the book, giving the overall themes, character relationships, and a critique of the author's style. Highly recommended for anyone interested in reading experimental fiction, but unsure of whether to take the leap with the book first.
