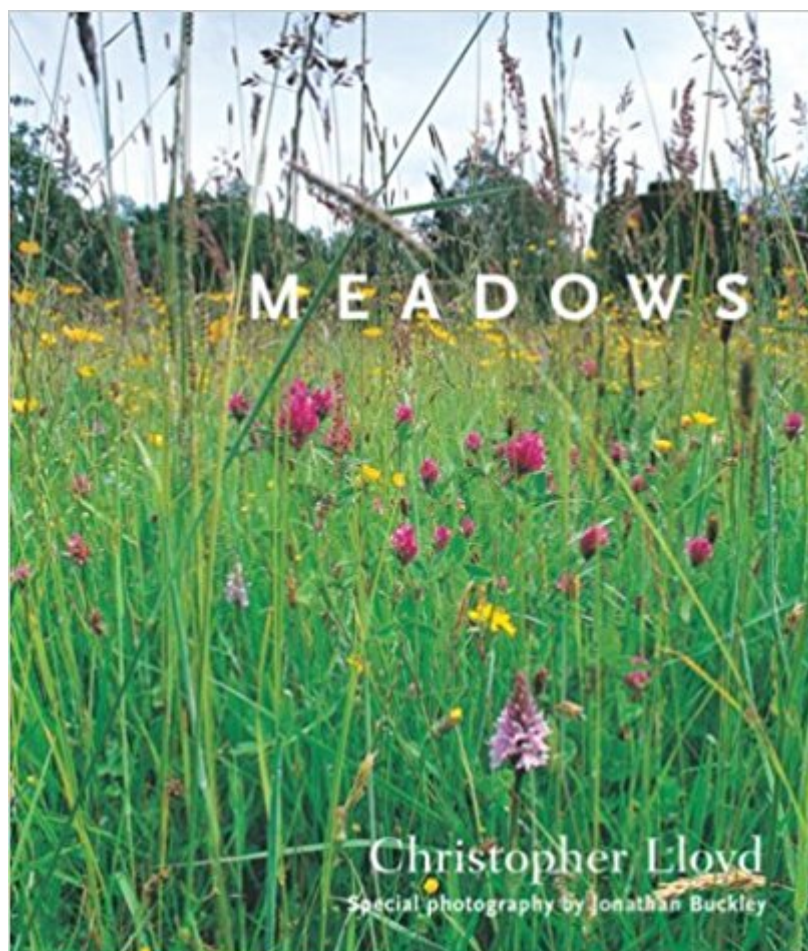

His own glorious landscape at Great Dixter exemplifies ways to cultivate areas where grasses meld with irises and buttercups, clover and wild orchids.
