

Windshock, by Mary Gallagher: A group of teenagers tell the story of a family at odds with each other and a mysterious stranger who changes their lives forever. Reindeer Soup, by Joe Pintauro: A motherless family tried to survive in the frozen tundra of Northern Canada in the face of a hostile environment, a dysfunctional father, a mystic Eskimo, and a reindeer named Norman. Sightings and High Tide, by Brad Slaight: In the first of these two one-act plays, an unusual prom night finds three teenagers wrestling with social pressures, complicated by a promised visit from afar. In the second, a chance meeting with two girls on a Southern California beach helps two young men sort out their feelings about the death of their best friend.

They include Timothy Mason's Ascension Day, Mary Gallagher's Windshook, Joe Pintauro's Reindeer Soup, and Brad Slaight's Sightings and High Tide. In these dramas, we find young people

faced with decisions about life and death, love and hatred, family and peer relations.
