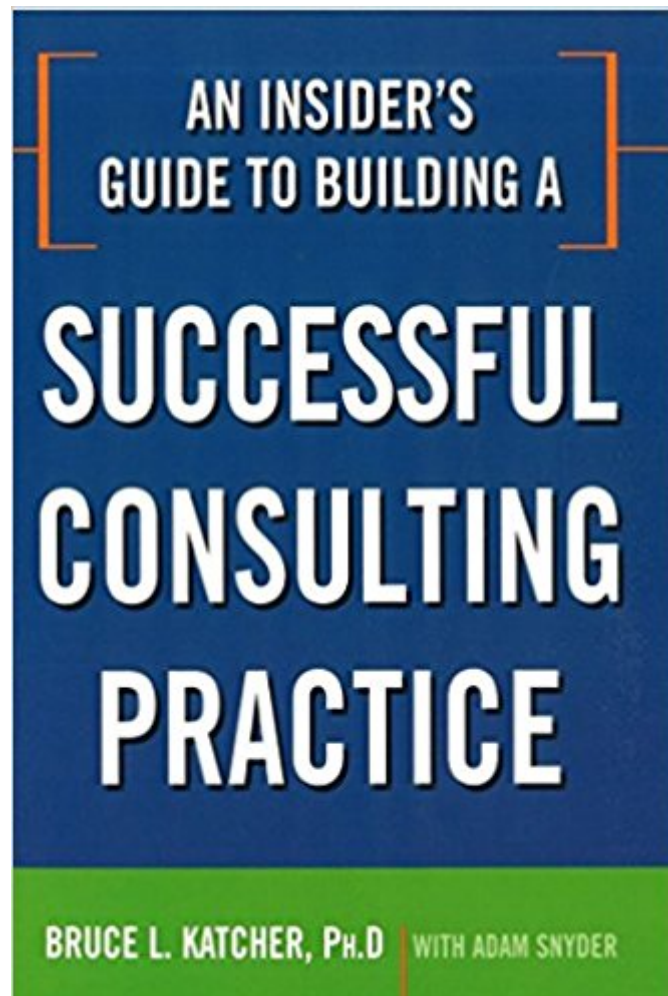

The Kindle edition is fine despite poor readability of some charts. In general, this is a excellent purchase.
