

Spaniel's book provides an introduction to the more technical aspects of negotiation and game theory. It is well written and concise and is just enough for smart people who want to get an edge in

negotiation situations.

For anyone wanting to learn about the basics of game theory, I would recommend starting out with this book. First, it is light on the math, which is not my strong suit, and second, it provides real-world situations. I must say that I appreciate the use of real-world situations/examples. This helps me to figure how to apply game theory concepts to situations I can find all around me and intuitively measure its value/usefulness when applying it to personal real-life situations. William's book is logical and well thought out.
