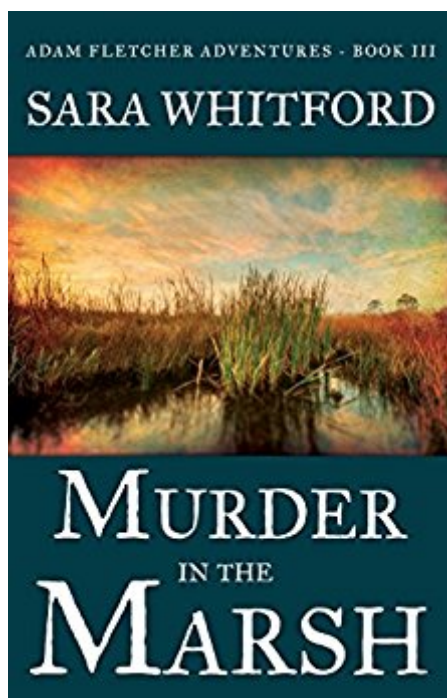


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Murder In The Marsh (Adam Fletcher Adventure Series Book 3)
