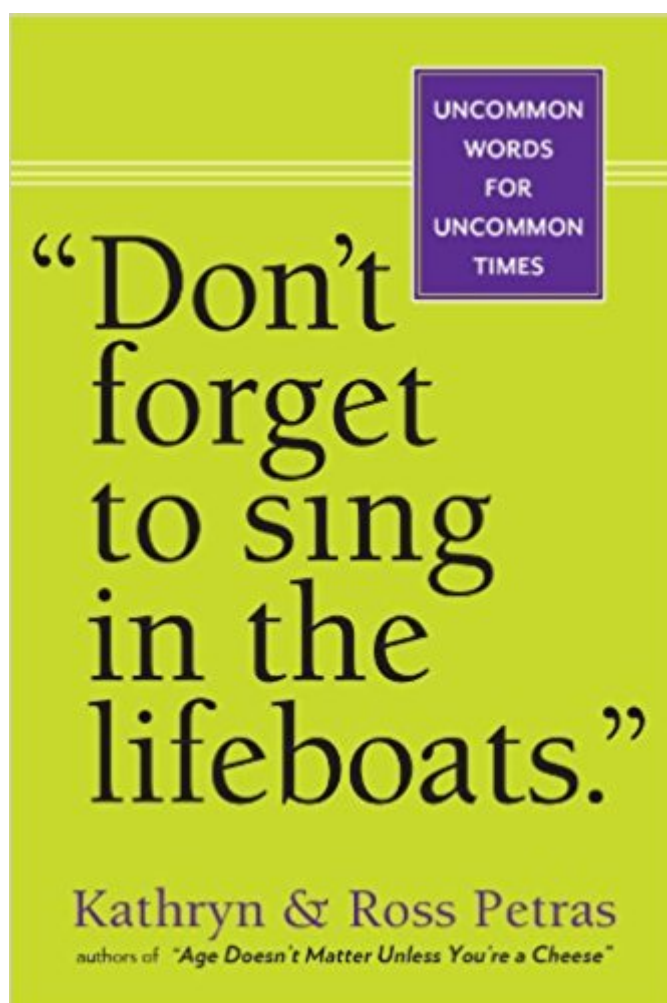


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"Don't Forget To Sing In The Lifeboats": Uncommon Wisdom For Uncommon Times
