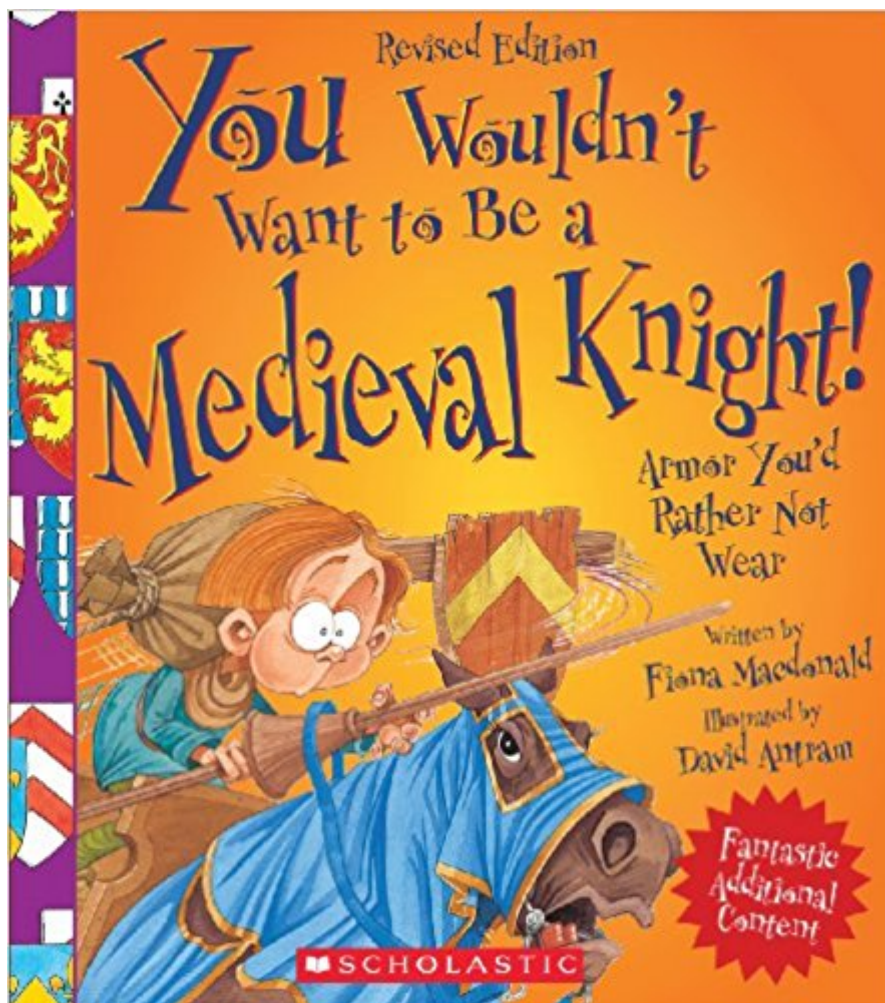


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You Wouldn't Want To Be A Medieval Knight! (Revised Edition)
