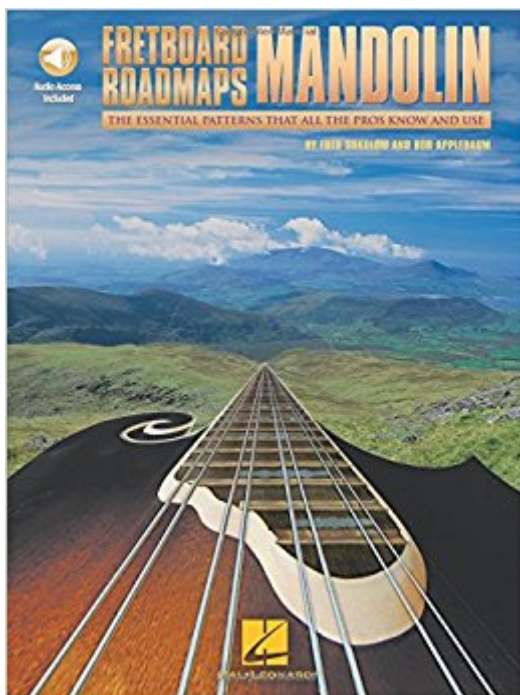

The book starts off well enough. It goes through the very basics, shows you some chords, how to construct scales, and then onto some brief scale exercises. However, the author somehow believes that after that small amount of background, a player can transition to playing intermediate-level tunes with some rather difficult syncopation and the addition of slides and blue notes. What's worse is that the tunes are played at full speed on the CD, making it pretty much useless as a tool to develop enough familiarity with the music to be able to have an ear for what you are aiming to sound like. Just my opinion of course, but I would not feel confident expecting a student to go from learning a few brief scale exercises to playing Nine Pound Hammer in A with slides and blue notes. If you are an intermediate or advanced player, you already know most of the material in this book anyway. There is very little to be learned from it aside from a few tidbits and some ideas. If you are a beginner, stick with books that spend more time developing skills in a cumulative fashion, and that

provide recorded examples that are played at a reasonable tempo. Greg Horne's books are great for this as they introduce things gradually, and offer skills-based tunes and exercises to give you a solid foundation from which to advance. And there are many other books that do the same.

The information layout was good, the pictures and charts were helpful.
