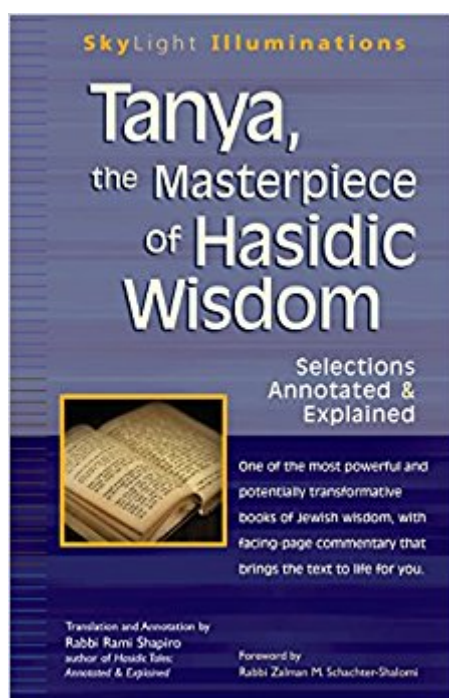


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Tanya The Masterpiece Of Hasidic Wisdom: Selections Annotated & Explained (SkyLight Illuminations)

Tanya, "It Was Taught," is one of the most powerful and potentially transformative books of Jewish wisdom. Written in 1797 by Rabbi Schneur Zalman of Liadi, the founder of Chabad Hasidism, Tanya sets forth the fundamentals of Jewish spirituality and mysticism. While a focus of daily study by tens of thousands of Hasidic Jews, Tanya is little known outside the world of Jewish mysticism. Until now, its kabbalistic terms and esoteric language have made this essential text of Jewish spirituality inaccessible to most readers. In this engaging volume, Rabbi Rami Shapiro offers a contemporary English translation of key selections of Tanya coupled with commentary designed to clarify and amplify the wisdom it contains. He also outlines the philosophical and spiritual framework on which Tanya is based—God's nonduality; the five dimensions of reality and their corresponding intelligences (body, heart, mind, soul, and spirit); the purpose of mitzvot, the practices of Jewish life, as catalysts to God realization and the hallowing of all life through godliness—to help you understand the selected Tanya translations in a way that enhances your own spiritual development. Now you can benefit from the wisdom of Tanya even if you have no previous knowledge of Judaism or Hebrew terminology. This SkyLight Illuminations edition presents the core teachings of Tanya, with insightful yet unobtrusive commentary that will deepen your understanding of the soul and how it relates to and manifests the Divine Source from which all life comes, in which all life lives and to which all life returns.

The Tanya is a difficult book to read without a knowledgeable guide. Rabbi Rami Shapiro has provided that in these well chosen selections. He has culled the Tanya to find passages that support most, if not all, of his theological concerns. While not as radical a reading as we find in his translation and commentary of Ecclesiastes (for instance there is talk of the different levels of the soul here, whereas in The Wisdom of Solomon, soul is ejected as nothing but a construct) still this work gives a good overview of Shapiro's ideas of God's radical immanence which borders on a kind of pantheism, his ideas of yesh (being) and ayin (nothingness) as the two combined poles of God, his belief in that we are all extensions of God, and the necessity of tzedakah and acts of chesed, kindness. This book is a valuable first reading of the Tanya, and separates it from strict Chabad interpretative control.

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
