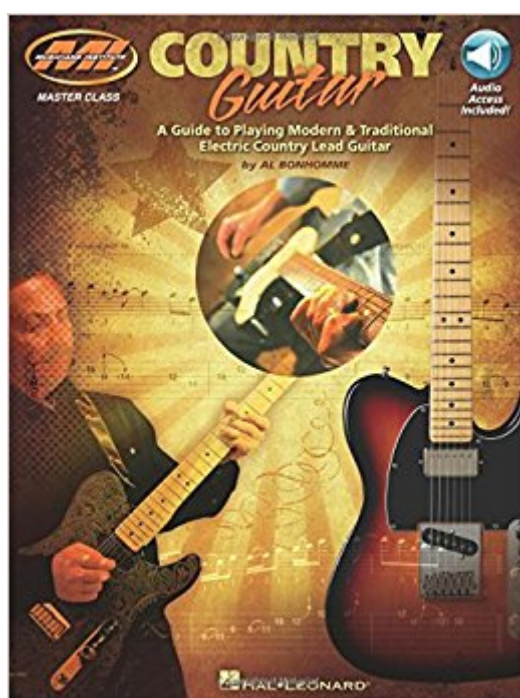


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Country Guitar: A Guide To Playing Modern & Traditional Electric Country Lead Guitar (Musicians Institute Master Class)

I would expect nothing less than from the musicians and teachers of the Musicians' Institute, originally founded as the Guitar Institute of Technology on Hollywood and Vine by Howard Roberts and Pat Hicks in the mid-'70s. I worked for them in those days and they brought jazz virtuoso Joe DiGorio (look him up on Wikipedia) from Florida to teach at the Institute. I don't remember if Howard's wife, Patty, has a better recollection of the details, but this is how the world-famous Musicians' Institute evolved. Howard and Patty had moved to Coos Bay, Oregon, during this time, or shortly thereafter. I am one of the fortunate ones who watched the Institute develop first-hand. I used to publicize The Howard Roberts Seminar nationwide, the precursor to the Guitar Institute of Technology. My consciousness was expanded so much that sometimes I think I actually understood Howard's thought processes. He taught me so much, and he would be proud of Bonhomme's book. Al, you've done more than teach the techniques; concentrate your next book on soloing and memorizing the songs as you say you should in this volume. When you do, it is important to point out, as you do, the type of scale being used and how they connect. (Howard was a whiz at sliding on the half steps to connect scales; and I'll tell you something he may never have told you, "Play primarily pentatonic scales when you keep up with the changes in Coltrane's "Giant Steps.") I have just about everything from those days that he'd allow me to keep, except his Ron Benson amp. Can't have it all.

Al's a real player and a real teacher (rare to find both). He knows what is needed on the bandstand and he teaches at Musicians Institute so knows how to teach it as well. His book has so much useful stuff in it and his playing is great. I love how he's covered so many aspects of Country guitar. Highly recommend.
