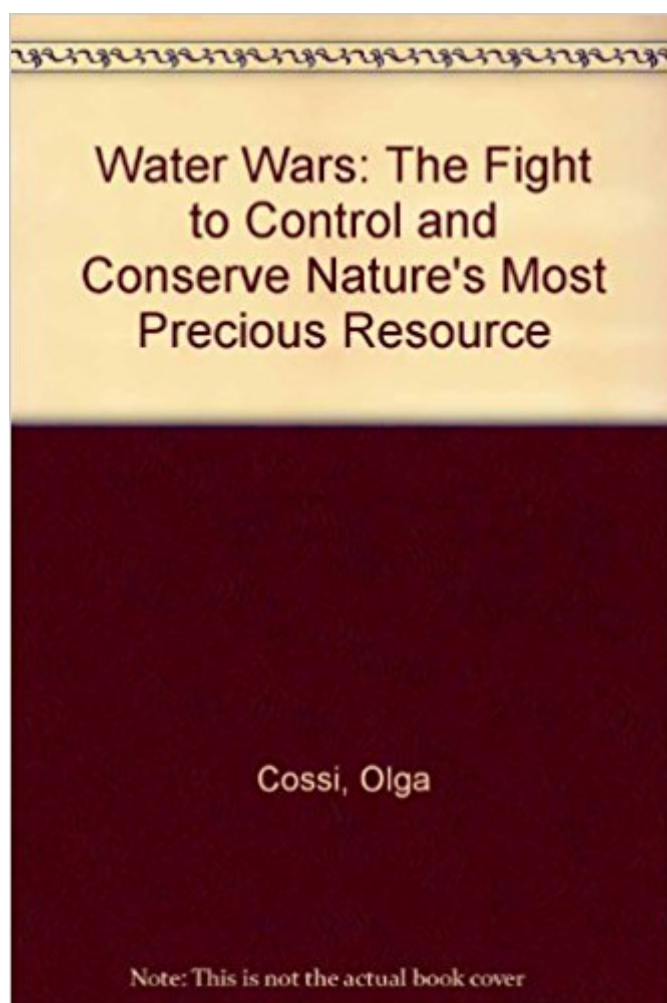

By examining southern California, the Middle East, and East Africa, Cossi shows exactly how these trouble spots became so tense about water and the local and international ramifications of long-term policy making. Researchers will find the book invaluable and general readers will enjoy its jargon-free science writing, memorable facts, and interesting comparisons. This title is shorter and easier to read than *Water* (Information Plus, 1993). While there are no maps or other illustrative material included, a chronology of major federal acts concerning water, addresses of groups and organizations to contact for information, and an up-to-date list for further reading are appended. Detailing water's sources and uses, her concise study clearly defines the hydrological cycle and describes the major reasons for water shortages. She analyzes water-quality problems and management programs and graphically relates the intense "war" for freshwater resources currently taking place in California and the Middle East. She also includes tips to help readers conserve and ensure cleaner water. Teachers will find the boldface scientific terms and the inclusion of a glossary handy for science vocabulary enrichment.
