

It seems as if the book was a combination of many blog post, which is fine but you need a good editor. No need to tell me the same thing 3,4, or 10 times, just say it once, I got it. I felt like the book would have been considerably shorter if edited better. The book is not written as advice for two working parents. Unfortunately not every family can have someone stay at home. Advice such as when going to the pediatrician make sure both parents go is flippant and unhelpful because it's not actually possible.
